1. **Task Order Title:** Prometheus Reactor Development Programmatic EIS

2. **Purpose, Objective, and Background of Work to be Performed:**

2.1 The overall objective of this task order is to provide expertise in the preparation of NASA's Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement (PEIS) for reactor technology development under NASA's Project Prometheus. The environmental impact Statement (EIS) will be compliant with Council on Environmental Quality (CEQ) Regulations, NASA's National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) policy and implementing regulations (14 CFR 1216.1 and 1216.3), and NASA's guidance for the preparation of NEPA documents (NASA Procedural Requirements 8580.1). [REDACTED] activities on behalf of the Prometheus Reactor Technology Development PEIS were initiated under [REDACTED] contract NAS1-00095 Task Order 80. Through this new task order [REDACTED] shall continue to work on and complete the Reactor Technology Development NEPA process, including, but not limited to preparation of the associated NEPA documents and assembling and maintaining the associated Administrative Record for this activity. [REDACTED] shall serve as an integral member of NASA's Reactor Technology Development NEPA Team with responsibility for preparation of draft NEPA notices and for critical technical NEPA compliance review of all inputs prepared by individual Team members for the PEIS. NASA's NEPA Team consists of, but may not be limited to, NASA Headquarters (Exploration Systems Mission Directorate, HQ Environmental Management Division, Office of General Counsel and others as appropriate), the Prometheus Project Office, JPL, SAIC, and DOE and its contractors.

3. **Description of the Work to be Performed:** The Contractor shall perform the following task requirements:

- 3.1 Prepare a draft outline of the Prometheus Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement document and prepare and maintain a working schedule for the overall effort.
- 3.2 Prepare and maintain a copy of the Administrative Record for the Prometheus Programmatic Environmental Impact Statement effort per direction of the NASA NEPA team, including NASA's legal counsel.
- 3.3 Prepare and maintain a Master Mailing list for the PEIS. The List shall use similar lists previously developed for the Mars Exploration Rover 2003 EIS, the Pluto-Kuiper Belt EIS and the Radioisotope Power System PEIS as a means of identifying organizations and individuals that may have an interest in this activity and the NEPA process. [REDACTED] shall include organizations and individuals suggested by the NASA NEPA team,

including suggestions from DOE and its contractors on the Master Mailing list, and use available stakeholder lists (e.g., those maintained by DOE and others as directed by the NASA NEPA team).

- 3.4 Prepare a Draft PEIS, distribute to the NASA NEPA team for their review, revise the draft based upon comments received from NEPA team members and from others deemed appropriate by the NASA NEPA team, and prepare a PEIS revision for NASA Management Concurrence review.
- 3.5 Categorize, summarize, and resolve Draft PEIS Concurrence Review comments, revise the document accordingly, prepare a draft Notice of Availability (NOA) for the Draft PEIS for NASA publication in the Federal Register, and deliver the completed document in suitable formats to NASA for printing and distribution to the public and for posting on a NASA web site.
- 3.6 Prepare final draft of all required NEPA notices for publication by NASA in the Federal Register and will prepare supportive technical analysis and documents in support of NASA's preparation of an agency Record of Decision.
- 3.7 Assist NASA with public meetings, including arranging for meeting spaces, preparation of newspaper advertisements, preparation of meeting plans and presentation materials, providing for stenographic and transcription services, review of Responses to Queries (RTQs and participation in the meetings. Public meetings will be held to collect comments regarding the Draft PEIS following issuance of the NOA. The public meetings are expected to consist of a NASA/contractor employee briefing at KSC, a presentation to members of the media and three public comment meetings (two in the KSC area and one in Washington D.C.).

(At this time NASA is considering a re-opening of the Reactor Development Notice of Intent (NOI) public comment period, stemming from the pending decision to redirect Reactor Development efforts to focus on extra-terrestrial surface power rather than propulsion power. Once the decision regarding re-opening the NOI is made, a decision by NASA is expected regarding the need to hold additional scoping meetings, including the number, location, and specific dates of meetings to be held.)

- 3.8 Review all comments received during the Draft PEIS public review period; ensure that appropriate responses regarding the comments are prepared; analyze, summarize and compile such comments; and develop responses and supporting documents for incorporation into the Final PEIS. SAIC shall prepare a Final PEIS Team review version, supporting technical documents, as requested, and distribute such documents for NASA NEPA team review and disposition.


